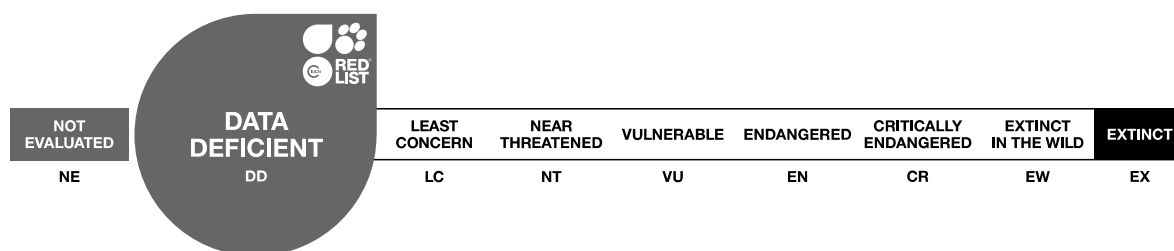

Justification:

Esta especie se considera como Datos Insuficientes (DD) debido a que si bien hay algunos datos sobre sus hábitats y ecología, que permiten establecer las amenazas que podrían estar afectando la especie, no se cuenta con un estudio taxonómico reciente que valide la pertenencia de la especie al grupo taxonómico que se menciona. Adicionalmente los datos de las colecciones registradas son contrastantes, pues mientras la colección tipo es un registro de A. Lindig a 2.600 m de elevación, la especie con registro georreferenciado, pertenece a San Andrés y Providencia, no obstante se registra como identificación dudosa.

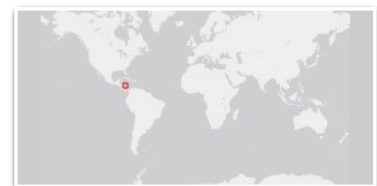
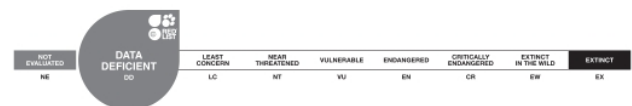
